Volunteering

We were approached by Patteson Lodge Activity Centre in Coltishall to ask if we could provide a team to paint some outdoor equipment. On the 7th and 8th October we collected clients and mentors and set off to discover what we would be doing. Day one was a climbing frame and day two a building. We had a lot of fun!

Thank God for this opportunity and pray that it is something the clients will remember with a smile. Please pray that it helped with their confidence, skills and relationship with their mentors.

Mentors & Clients

We currently have 18 active mentors and 27 clients. We have closed a few clients over the last couple of months; some for no longer engaging and others due to them moving out of the area. One has completed the Teen Challenge rehab programme and their leadership course and will soon be moving to Scotland to work with the homeless there. Some clients have been released after long sentences and need more support to learn how society and technology have moved on. Others are coping with some degree of mental health and addiction and find it more difficult to stay out of prison. We continue to help these 'revolving door' clients and are gradually seeing improvement.

Thank God for our mentors who give of their time both physically and mentally to support their client/s. Pray for wisdom as they seek to build relationships yet keep boundaries and provide appropriate support.

We are really seeing a positive shift in how we all connect and this is helping to speed up help for clients.




Christmas Social
